



### TODAY'S GOSPEL MESSAGE

Sunday, April 7, 2024 John 20:19-31

The disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord. Jesus said to them again, 'Peace be with you. As the Father has sent me, so I send you.' And when he had said this, he breathed on them and said to them, 'Receive the Holy Spirit...Have you come to believe because you have seen me? Blessed are those who have not seen and have believed.'

### Reflection

"Besides missing seeing the risen Lord in the flesh, Saint Thomas also missed receiving the Holy Spirit on that first day of the week. Perhaps his doubt and disbelief stemmed from not having the Holy Spirit within him to guide him to the truth. We have each received the Holy Spirit in baptism, so we have an advantage Thomas did not have at the time. Let us allow the Holy Spirit to guide us to the truth."

### DAILY READINGS FOR THE WEEK

**Monday** Isaiah 7:10-14; 8:10; Hebrews 10:4-10; Luke 1:26-38 The Annunciation of the Lord (Solemnity) — This feast celebrates the wondrous event that binds God and humanity forever. Christ, the Word who becomes the Son of Mary, is enfleshed in her womb, making Mary the Mother of God. The liturgy celebrates the beginning of God's new redemptive work and recognizes Mary as the 'new Eve,' the obedient and faithful woman who agreed to be a participant in God's plan of salvation.

**Wednesday** Acts of the Apostles 5:17-26; John 3:16-21

**Thursday** Acts of the Apostles 5:27-33; John 3:31-36

<u>Saint Stanislaus</u>. <u>Bishop and Martyr (Memorial)</u> – Born in Poland, Stanislaus became a priest and a canon of the cathedral in Krakow. He was an eloquent preacher, a generous benefactor of the poor, and an advocate for clerical reform. He was soon embroiled in conflict with King Boleslaus II, who eventually killed Stanislaus during a celebration of Mass.



### "The Courage to Go to Jesus

This is important: the courage to trust in Jesus' mercy, to trust in his patience, to seek refuge always in the wounds of his love. . . .

Maybe someone among us here is thinking: my sin is so great, I am as far from God as the younger son in the parable; my unbelief is like that of Thomas. I don't have the courage to go back, to believe that God can welcome me and that he is waiting for me, of all people. But God is indeed waiting for you; he asks of you only the courage to go to him.

How many times in my pastoral ministry have I heard it said, 'Father, I have many sins,' and I have always pleaded, 'Don't be afraid; go to him; he is waiting for you; he will take care of everything.' We hear many offers from the world around us, but let us take up God's offer instead: his is a caress of love."

### DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY APRIL 7, 2024

In the 1930s, Jesus chose a humble Polish nun, Maria Faustina Kowalska, to receive private revelations concerning Divine Mercy that were recorded in her diary. St. Faustina's diary records 14 occasions when Jesus requested that a Feast of Mercy (Divine Mercy Sunday) be observed. On May 5, 2000, five days after the canonization of St. Faustina, the Vatican decreed that the Second Sunday of Easter would henceforth be known as Divine Mercy Sunday.

### PRAYING THE DIVINE MERCY CHAPLET


(using ordinary Rosary Beads)

### **Optional Opening Prayers:**

You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world.

- O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.
- 1. Make the Sign of the Cross.
- 2. Repeat three times: O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fountain of Mercy for us, I trust in You!
- 3. Pray an Our Father.
- 4. Pray a Hail Mary.
- 5. Pray the Apostles' Creed.
- 6. On the Our Father beads, pray: Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.
- 7. On the Hail Mary beads, pray: For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
- 8. Repeat for the five decades.
- 9. *Repeat three times*: Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.
