

## TODAY'S GOSPEL MESSAGE Sunday, June 9, 2024 Mark 3:20-35

Jesus came home with his disciples. . .When his relatives heard of this they set out to seize him, for they said, "He is out of his mind." The scribes who had come from Jerusalem said, "He is possessed by Beelzebul," and "By the prince of demons he drives out demons...Summoning them, he began to speak to them in parables, "Amen, I say to you, all sins and all blasphemies that people utter will be forgiven them. But whoever blasphemes against the Holy Spirit will never have forgiveness, but is guilty of an everlasting sin"...A crowd seated around him told him, "Your mother and your brothers and your sisters are outside asking for you." And looking around at those seated in the circle he said, "Here are my mother and my brothers. For whoever does the will of God is my brother and sister and mother."

## Reflection

"In disputing the scribes' absurd contention that Jesus is able to drive out demons because he is possessed by the prince of demons, Jesus warns of blaspheming against the Holy Spirit. By doing so, he implies that the Holy Spirit allows him to drive out the unclean spirits. We received the Holy Spirit in baptism and so we too have the Holy Spirit within us. May we use the power of the Holy Spirit in us to drive out the demons who threaten to destroy our lives."

**Tuesday** Acts of the Apostles 11:21b-26; 13:1-3; Matthew 5:13-16 <u>Saint Barnabas</u>. <u>Apostle (*Memorial*)</u> – Barnabas, a Jew from Cyprus, came to Jerusalem and joined the early Christian community. It was Barnabas who accepted Paul into the community after his conversion and who was at Paul's side for many years in evangelizing the Gentiles.

**Thursday** 1 Kings 18:41-46; Matthew 5:20-26

Saint Anthony of Padua. Priest and Doctor of the Church (*Memorial*) – Born in Portugal, he joined the Canons Regular of Saint Augustine and became a biblical scholar. His contact with some Franciscans inspired him to join the Franciscans. He was sent to Italy where his great oratorical gifts were noted. He is best known for his help in finding lost objects.


